


USEFUL EXPRESSION

A. Basic instruction





SEMI-FOWLER'S POSITION (with head of bed 30°-60°) Now, I (want/need) to elevate/lower the head of your bed.



SIDE LYING/SIDEWAYS

- Now, I want you tointo side-lying
- Would you.....
- I need to help you.....

change your position roll yourself

SIM'S POSITION

Patient in complete side-lying position, but move further to the far side of the bed. Partially roll patient forward partly on abdomen.

Instruction: see above



PRONE POSITION

I need to help you Let me help you I want you to

change your position with face downwards change your position to lie on your tummy.



I will (put/place) this (pillow) under your stomach. Just extend your right elbow.

Place your left hand under your hip.

That's fine.
